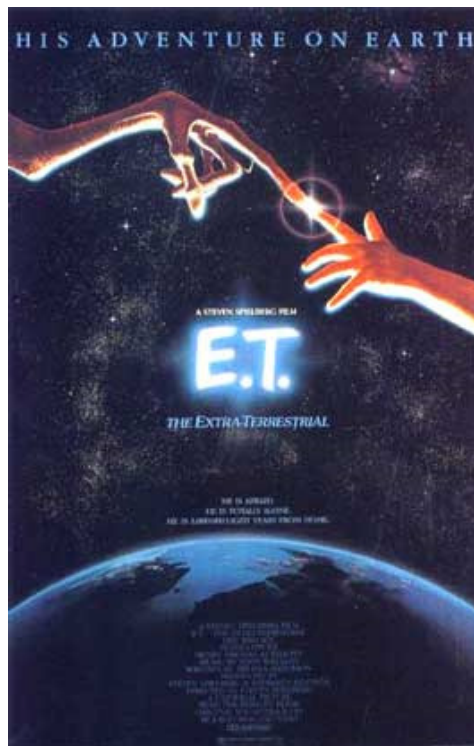
Films will continue every other Saturday through February 28, 2009, and will include *North by Northwest*, *Annie*, and *The Princess Bride*, respectively.

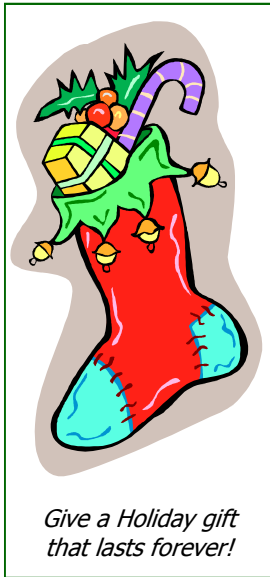
