### **READING AND WRITING FUND GRANT AWARDED TO WILLIAMSPORT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

A \$947.39 grant was awarded to Williamsport Elementary School from the Reading and Writing Fund. This grant is rotated annually between the three local elementary schools!

We gave you a one week notice and on Giving Tuesday by 4:30pm, more than \$7,500 of donations came into the Co-Op. We were thrilled to be able to provide the \$7,500 match.

## **DOES YOUR ORGANIZATION NEED A GRANT FOR A PROJECT?**

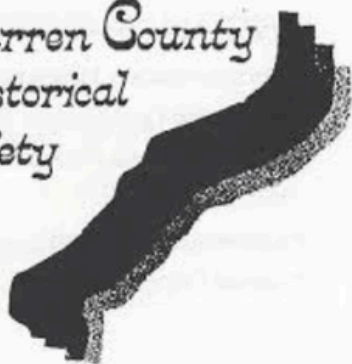
