
Presentation about Food Security of Warren County There were 20

Traiga sus tarjetas de seguro. Aceptamos y facturamos todos los seguros (comerciales, Medicare, Medicaid). No hay ningún costo para quienes no tienen seguro, con la excepción de la vacuna contra la culebrilla y el RSV ya que con frecuencia se requiere un copago.

Se proporcionarán todas las vacunas recomendadas por los CDC. Consultaremos el registro estatal de vacunación para evaluar las necesidades de vacunación de cada individuo. Si desea rechazar una vacuna específica, comuníquese con la Coalición de Inmunización de Indiana al menos 48 horas antes del evento a clinic@vaccinateindiana.org

Walk-ins the day of the clinic are welcome, but we MUST have parent/guardian consent if under the age of 18.

Please upload or send the immunization records for the individual who is getting vaccinated.

Please bring your insurance cards. We accept and bill all insurance (commercial, Medicare, Medicaid). There is no cost to those without insurance, except for the Shingles and adult RSV vaccines, as there is often a required co-pay.

All CDC recommended vaccines will be provided. We will consult the state immunization registry to assess the immunization needs of each individual. If you would like to refuse a specific vaccine, please contact the Indiana Immunization Coalition at least 48 hours prior to the event at clinic@vaccinateindiana.org.










APPLY FOR A GRANT
