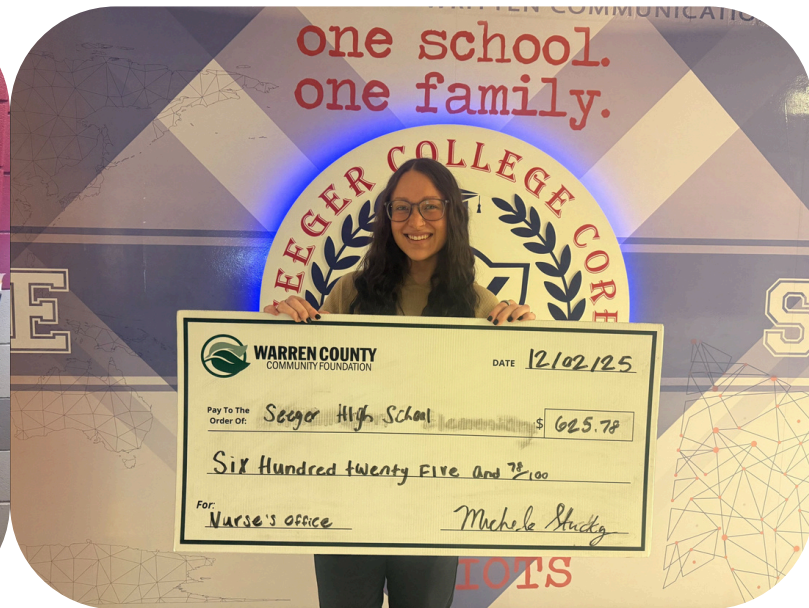

## RECENT GRANTS



### LOCAL SCHOOL NURSE'S OFFICES RECEIVED GRANT

All four Nurse's Offices in the Warren County schools received a \$625.78 grant from three combined funds. The Lioness Marie Ducker Fund is primarily used for eyeglass needs, the Randy Capp Fund for child health care needs, and the Joey Lee Lawson Fund for youth, healthcare, and education. Each school Nurse was encouraged to use this money to better assist in their care for students with the goals of each fund in mind!





## MELINDA MCNICHOLS ETCHISON MENTORING FUND AWARDS GRANT

The Melinda McNichols Etchison Mentoring Fund was established as a way to guide and assist Seeger students on their path to college through mentorship. This fund has since grown to benefit other organizations within our community. A \$2,400 grant was awarded to A Better Way Co Op. In 2026, there will be a monthly fellowship with the Co-Op members with a meal and sharing of scripture as well as financial guidance. This grant will pay for the cost of the food for the events as well as any needed supplies.



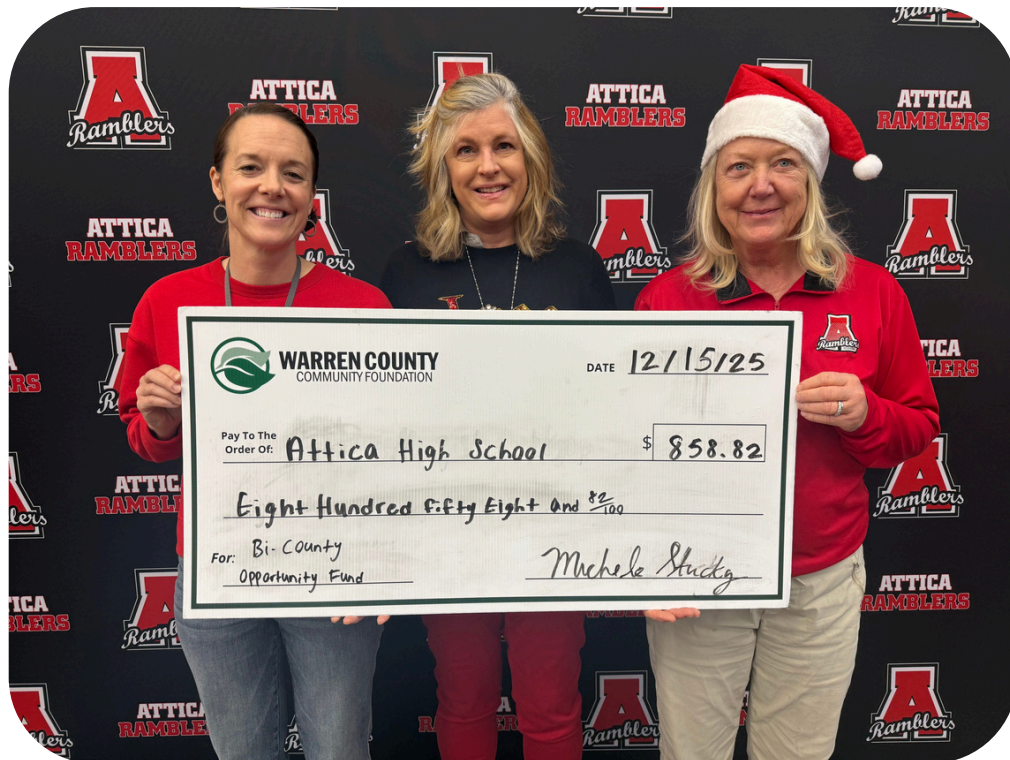
## A BETTER WAY CO OP AWARDED GRANT FROM THE WARREN COUNTY HUNGER FUND

Established in 2011, the Warren County Hunger Fund is an endowment, which grants projects that aid in food support, such as: the food pantries, the summer lunch program, the food backpack program, and many more. This month, this fund has awarded \$4,000 to A Better Way Co Op! This will greatly impact the Co-Op as they aid members within our community through and after the holiday season.



## **FELLURE FAMILY LEGACY FUND AWARDS GRANT TO SPECIAL OLYMPICS INDIANA**

Every year, the Fellure Family selects a charitable organization for their annual grant. This year, they have chosen to award a \$312.36 grant to Special Olympics Indiana- Warren Fountain County. This grant will help them continue to provide awesome opportunities and events for local Special Olympic Athletes!



## **ATTICA HIGH SCHOOL RECEIVES GRANT FROM BI-COUNTY OPPORTUNITY FUND**

The Bi-County Opportunity Fund, a fund dedicated to assisting programs for students, awarded \$858.82 to Attica High School this month. This year the grant will be used to help fund Biztown for 2026!





## WARREN COUNTY HUNGER FUND AWARDS GRANTS TO LOCAL BACKPACK PROGRAMS

Pine Village, Williamsport, Warren Central, and Seeger all received a \$500 grant from the Warren County Hunger Fund! This fund assists local programs working to fight food insecurity and will help the local Backpack programs at all four schools in providing students with weekly backpacks filled with food and hygiene items.



## LOCAL BLAST PROGRAM AWARDED COMMUNITY GRANT

BLAST, and after-school enrichment program, stands for Believing, Learning, and Sharing Together. On the first Thursday of each month, Williamsport Elementary School students can participate in after school biblically themed stations. Volunteers from Hickman Heights Christian Church teach these stations including cooking, crafts, games, story time, snacks, and lessons. This group hosts five events per year, as well as coordinating the Williamsport Backpack Program. About 75-100 students attend each event!

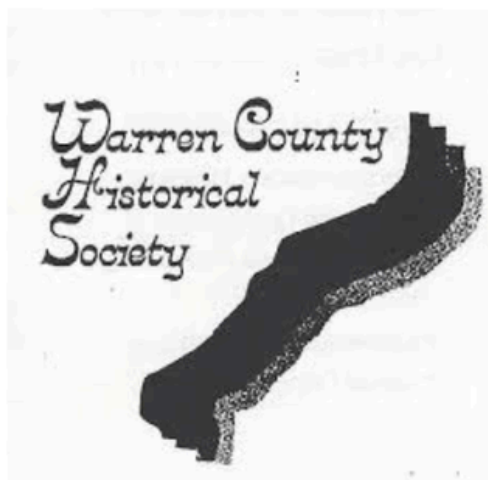
