HANGING ROCK RECEIVES GRANT

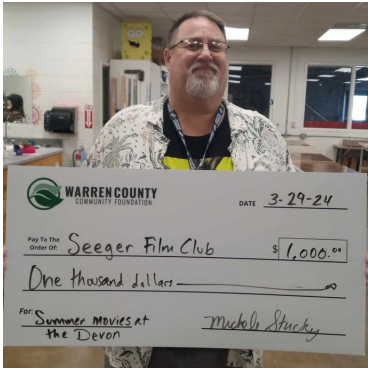

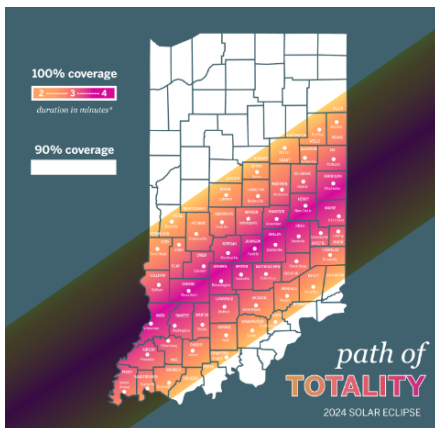
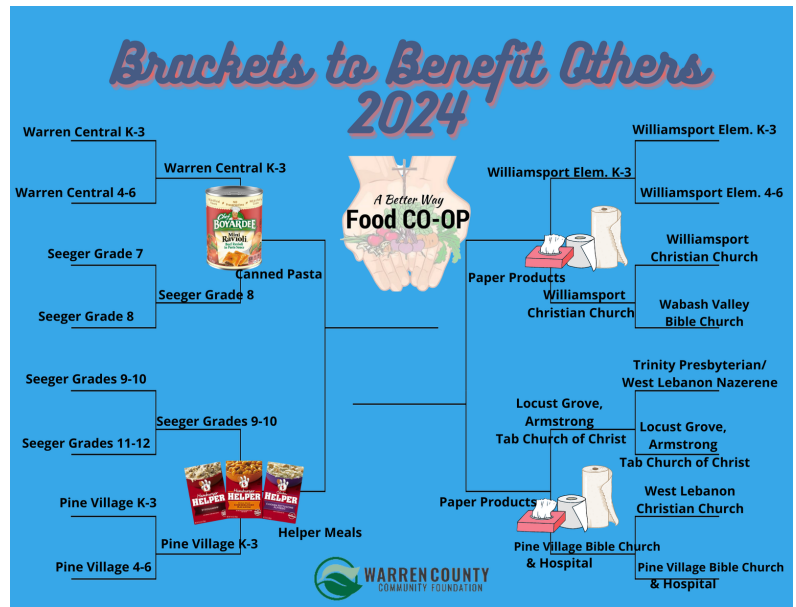
