



LOCAL ARTIST ZAC CODY COMPLETES MURAL AT CICOTT

ZAC CODY OF NATURE MATTERS LLC FINISHED ANOTHER WARREN COUNTY MURAL AT CICOTT TRADING POST PARK. THE MURAL FEATURES A 3-PART SCENE. ON THE RIGHT SIDE IS THE WABASH SPLITTING WARREN AND FOUNTAIN COUNTY, WITH FUR TRADERS FLOATING DOWN ON CANOES. THE CENTRAL PORTION SHOWS CICOTT'S SECOND TRADING POST. ZAC DID RESEARCH AT THE WARREN COUNTY INDIANA HISTORICAL SOCIETY AND MET WITH JOHN HENRY, ONE OF THE FOUNDING BOARD MEMBERS AND THE CATALYST FOR THE PROPERTY TO BECOME A COUNTY PARK. THE SITE ITSELF WAS THOUGHT TO BE SITUATED ON A KNOLL ABOVE THE WABASH WHICH ZAC TRIED TO REPRESENT. THE TRADING POST IS SHOWN AS AN ACTIVE SITE WITH FURS BEING DRIED ON STANDS AND BUNDLES OF GOODS STACKED UP OUTSIDE OF THE POST WAITING TO BE PROCESSED. ON THE LEFT SIDE IS THE GRAND PRAIRIE WHERE HISTORICALLY THERE IS A DIVERSITY IN PLANT AND TREE SPECIES WITH THE CONTINENTAL SHIFT FROM EASTERN FORESTS TO PRAIRIE. EVEN THOUGH THIS PARTICULAR SITE WOULD HAVE HISTORICALLY BEEN AN OAK WOODLAND, MANY PARTS OF WARREN COUNTY HAVE A HISTORY OF PRAIRIES. COME AND CHECK OUT THIS NEW PROJECT!
