

Coach Cook's Kids



The Coach Cook's Kids Fund was created in memory of Thomas Cook in 2016 by his son's Jesse, Zach, Elijah, and Jacob Cook. Coach Thomas Cook was widely recognized as an active member in the Warren County community, but he was most known for his days of coaching and teaching at high schools in surrounding areas. From 1996 to 2016, Cook taught physical education and health at Seeger High School. He also coached football, including the 2003 state runner-up and the 2004 state championship teams, and wrestling, where he was the winningest coach in school history. He was a member of the Indiana Football Coaches Association, Indiana High School Wrestling Coaches Association, and was a two-time inductee into the Indiana Wrestling Hall of Fame.

Always a champion of the underdog, Coach Cook volunteered much of his time to his students and athletes who needed him most. The Coach Cook's Kids Fund will continue his legacy as it works to support the Seeger Athletic Department to benefit students that are unable to pay for uniforms, physicals, sports camps, and similar sport related expenses for student athletes.
